1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing respondent No.2 to decide the case bearing No.MSME /HMSEFC/Case No.5283/24/6876, titled as 'M/s Dev Narayan Constructions Versus JVTAOA' (Annexure P-1).

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner submitted that proceedings under Section 18 of the MSMED Act, 2006 before respondent No.2/Haryana Micro & Small Enterprises Facilitation Council, Panchkula are pending from the year 2023 but the same have not been decided till date. He submitted that his limited prayer in the present petition is for issuance of a direction to respondent No.2-Haryana Micro & Small

Enterprises Facilitation Council, Panchkula to consider and decide the same in accordance with law within a time frame work.

3. At this stage, Mr. Udit Garg, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana has submitted that he has received an advance copy of the present petition and has also sought instructions from the concerned authority to state that the aforesaid matter is pending before respondent No.2- Haryana Micro & Small Enterprises Facilitation Council, Panchkula and the same will be considered and decided in accordance with law within a period of four months from today.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that in view of the statement made by learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed of.
