1. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that the respondent has already paid an amount of Rs.1,22,359/- in May, 2022 on account of performance security. It is further submitted that the respondent is in possession of two FDRs and will hand over the copy of the FDRs during the course of the day to the learned counsel for the petitioner which as per the stand of the respondent would satisfy the claim of the petitioner.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that in case any amount due to the petitioner is still left, then, the petitioner be granted liberty to give a detailed representation giving the details of the said amount

left along with the basis for the same and the competent officer of the



respondent authority be directed to decide the said representation in accordance with law and pass a speaking order thereon within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation. It is submitted that with the said liberty, the present petition be disposed of.

3. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that in case the representation is filed by the petitioner, the same would be decided within six weeks from the date of the receipt of the representation by passing a speaking order and in case any amount is found due, the same would be released expeditiously.

4. In view of the same, the present contempt petition is disposed with the liberty as prayed for by the petitioner. The respondent would be bound by the statement made before this Court.
