Short prayer made on behalf of the petitioners-landowners is
for release of annuity benefits in accordance with the award dated
11.09.2012 passed by the Land Acquisition Collector, Sonapat.

[2] Upon notice, no reply has been filed on behalf of the
respondent(s)-State of Haryana. However, learned State Counsel adopts the
reply as filed in identical controversy bearing **CWP-32050-2025**, titled
“Raghbir Versus State of Haryana and others”.

[3] At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that
the present matter is squarely covered by the judgment dated **28.11.2025**
passed by this Court in **CWP No. 33780 of 2024** titled as ***“Bijender Singh
and ors. Versus State of Haryana and ors.”***

[4] Learned counsel for the respondent(s)-State of Haryana is not
in a position to controvert the above factual position.

[5] After going through the judgment passed by this Court referred to above as well as the facts of the present case, this Court agrees with the assertion of the learned counsel for the petitioners.

[6] Consequently, the present writ petition is **disposed off** in the same terms as ***Bijender Singh’s case (supra)***.

[7] Pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off.
