Learned counsel for the respondent has brought to our notice that Hon'ble Supreme Court in Criminal Appeal Nos.1868-1870 of 2025 (arising out of Special Leave Petition (Crl.) Nos.137-139 of 2025) decided on 08.04.2025 titled as "M/s Celestium Financial Versus A. Gnanasekaran Etc." has held that appeal against an order of acquittal under the proviso to Section 372 Cr.P.C. is not maintainable before the High Court and instead it is maintainable before the Court of Session. This legal position is not disputed by learned counsel for the appellant.

In the circumstances, this appeal is sent to the learned Sessions Judge Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri who may decide the appeal himself or may assign the same to any Additional Sessions Judge.
