VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. In FAO-3239-2003, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants. Notices issued to appellants No.1, 2 and 4 has received back unserved with the report that appellants No.1, 2 and 4 has shifted to some unknown place at Amritsar. Appellant No.3 is reported to be dead. Even the previous counsel Ms. Poonam Singh Thakur and Mr. L.M. Gulati, Advocates has also been informed vide letters No.8360 and 8360 on 22.12.2025 but no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants. It seems that appellants are not interested in pursuing the instant appeal.

2. In FAO-753-2004, no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants. Appellants No.1, 4 and 5 served personally. Appellant No.2 is duly served through brother. Appellant No.3 is reported to be out of country. Even the previous counsel Ms. Poonam Singh Thakur and Mr. L.M. Gulati, Advocates has also been informed vide letters No.8361 and 8362 on 22.12.2025 but no one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellants. It seems that appellants are not interested in pursuing the instant appeal.

3. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping these appeals on the docket, indefinitely.

4. Accordingly, the appeals stand dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to the appellant or LRs of appellant, if any, to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order, within a period of three months from today.

5. As a natural corollary, since the main cases stand disposed of, all miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them.
