The present appeal had been filed by the appellant against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 10.08.2011 passed by the Judge, Special Court, Gurdaspur, in Sessions Case No.05 dated 11.01.2010, RBT No.40 dated 15.04.2010, whereby the appellant had been sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for a period of ten years and fine of Rs.1 Lakh under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

State counsel contends that an inquiry was conducted with respect to the status of the appellant Raj Kumar alias Jaggu son of Lubhaya Ram and as per said inquiry, Raj Kumar alias Jaggu i.e. the appellant herein has died about two years ago.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of as abated.

Liberty, however, is granted to the LR's of the appellant to seek revival in case they want to contest the present appeal.
