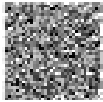

SUDEEPTI SHARMA, J. (Oral)

1. The contempt petition has been filed for deliberate and intentional disobedience of order dated 24.09.2019 passed in CWP-19664-2014.
2. Learned counsel for respondent contends that LPA filed against order dated 24.09.2019 bearing No.LPA-1843-2019 was dismissed and the State has filed SLP (C) Diary No.46242-2025, wherein, status quo order is passed by Hon'ble Supreme Court.
3. In view of the same, the contempt is dismissed.
4. Needless to say that liberty is however granted to the petitioner to avail the remedy as is available to him in accordance with law after the decision of SLP (C) Diary No.46242-2025.
5. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
