The present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ of certiorari, quo warranto and mandamus for quashing the appointments of private respondents No.3 to 7 to the post of Assistant Registrars.

A perusal of the pleadings would show that the challenge in the present petition is for appointments of the private respondents as Assistant Registrars way back in the year 1995 which is almost 29 years ago.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submitted that he may be granted some time to seek instructions.

It appears that since the aforesaid appointments were made 29 years ago, the subject matter of the petition may not survive.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed. However, in case any cause of action still survives, then the petitioners shall be at liberty to file any appropriate application for the revival of the petition.
