SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (ORAL)

1. Upon instructions from Dr. Shiraz Singh Cheema, Medical Officer, District Jail, Rupnagar, State counsel submits that the Medical Officer has opined that petitioner deserves to be hospitalized in view of her precarious medical condition. Reference has also been made by the State counsel to the medical report, Annexure R-1, filed along with the short reply filed by way of the affidavit of Superintendent, District Jail, Rupnagar.
2. In view thereof, respondents are directed to hospitalize the petitioner forthwith in a Government Hospital, as per relevant rules, so that she can get due medical care and attention. Period of hospitalization and discharge would be dependent upon the opinion of the treating doctor(s).



3. In view of the above, writ petition is disposed of.
