1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to grant salary to the petitioner with full allowance from 29.07.2016 to 31.12.2018 along with 18% interest after the withdrawal of order dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-10), vide order dated 06.01.2017 (Annexure P-9) and also to grant all retirement dues, gratuity, leave encashment etc. and regular pension on his retirement on 31.12.2018 with 18% interest and the respondents be directed to issue formal retirement of the petitioner from 31.12.2018 on attaining the age of 58 years. Further, directions have also been sought to withdraw the order dated 29.07.2016 by the Divisional Forest Officer, Ferozepur, issued vide Endst No.2823-28 dated 29.07.2016 (Annexure P-10), vide which stay was imposed on the order dated

20.12.2015, vide which the petitioner was regularised in the service.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars by impugning the order of dismissal dated 01.08.2025.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
