CM-6494-CWP-2026:

Prayer in the instant application is for restoration of the main writ petition (CWP-3062-2024), which was dismissed for non-prosecution, to its original number.

For the reasons mentioned in the present application, the same is allowed and the writ petition (CWP-3062-2024) is restored to its original

number and status; and is taken up on Board today itself.

CWP-3062-2024 (O&M):

Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Mandamus, directing the official respondents to remove the unauthorized encroachments made by respondents No.6 to 10 and their family members in Baba Budha Ji Nagar, Rama Mandi, Jalandhar, situated between Gali Nos.1 to 5, P.O. Dakoha, Tehsil and District Jalandhar, and also from the plot measuring 15 marlas owned by petitioner No.1, situated in the said locality in Hadbast No.223.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners, after arguing for some time, submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant writ petition with liberty to the petitioners to approach the Court of competent jurisdiction in accordance with law.

3. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.

4. All pending application(s), if any, shall also stand closed.
