1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 08.07.1999 vide which respondent No.2 has rejected the representation dated 15.06.1999 filed by the petitioner vide which he has prayed for continuance of special pay of Rs.120/- per month, and to quash letter (Annexure P-9) wherein it has been directed that additional pay of Rs.120/- per month be not given to the petitioner; further seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondent-University to pay to the petitioner the arrears of additional special pay of Rs.120/- per month granted to him vide notification dated 27.08.1993 (Annexure P-8).

2. On 22.09.2025, learned counsel for respondent No.2 had placed on record the photocopy of the death certificate of the petitioner and the case was adjourned for 16.03.2026. On 16.03.2026, time was sought by learned counsel for the petitioner for impleading the LR's of the petitioner. He submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the LR's of the petitioner.

3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is disposed of for want of prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the LR's of the petitioner to revive the same in case they are interested to pursue the present petition.
