1. The instant petition under Section 482 of BNSS, 2023 has been filed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No.308, dated 28.11.2025, under Sections 326(g), 194(2), 324(4), 126(2), 191(2), 190, 351(3), 115(2) and 61(2) of BNS 2023, registered at Police Station Division No.7, District Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.
2. This Court vide order dated 09.02.2026, while issuing notice of motion, granted the concession of interim bail to the petitioner, subject to his joining the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in pursuance to the order dated 09.02.2026, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel does not controvert the said fact and further submits that custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required.

5. In view of the above, the order dated 09.02.2026 is made absolute.
6. Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of.
