1. Grievance raised by petitioner is that in tender reference dated 01.07.2025 issued by respondent No.2, there is no mention or disclosure about petitioner's Right of First Refusal in terms of Concession Agreements already executed between petitioner and respondent No.1.

2. Learned counsel for respondent No.2, refers to e-mail dated 09.02.2026 from the General Manager, Equipment Division, Haryana Medical Services Corporation Limited, IT Park Panchkula to submit that present writ petition is rendered infructuous as the sites in question have been withdrawn vide Corrigendum dated 30.01.2026 and matter regarding Right of First Refusal is under consideration with the Director General, Health Services, Haryana -



respondent No.3. Relevant portion of communication dated 09.02.2026 reads as under :-

“In this regard, it is submitted that vide corrigendum dated 30.01.2026 HMSCL has already withdrawn the sites i.e. Civil Hospital Gurugram (CT Scan Services), Civil Hospital Panchkula (MRI & CT Scan Services), Civil Hospital Bhiwani (MRI & CT Scan Services), Civil Hospital Faridabad (MRI & CT Scan Services), Civil Hospital Sonipat (CT Scan Services), Civil Hospital Charkhi Dadri (MRI Services) on which Healthmap Diagnostics Private Limited and Others are already running CT/MRI Centres on Public Private Partnership (PPP) and matter related to Right of first Refusal is under consideration with O/o DGHS, Haryana.”

3. Said communication dated 09.02.2026 is taken on record subject to just exceptions.
4. Learned counsel for petitioner affirms and verifies that in view thereof, this writ petition is indeed rendered infructuous.
5. Writ petition is accordingly disposed of as infructuous.
