1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of orders dated 11.02.2000 and 18.07.2000 whereby her claim for appointment as Constable in Haryana Police was rejected.

2. Learned State counsel submits that petitioner was initially appointed as Water Carrier on companionate ground, however, during pendency of aforesaid petition vide order dated 14.02.2003 was appointed as Constable. She was not initially appointed as Constable because she was not matriculate. She did matric and respondent accepted her request. Thus, petition has rendered infructuous.

3. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous with liberty to petitioner to move an appropriate application within three months from today if cause survives.
