Though the prayer made in this application was for suspending the sentence of the applicants-appellants during the pendency of the present appeal, however, it is submitted by learned counsel for the applicants-appellants that during the pendency of the appeal, they have already undergone the entire sentence of ten years awarded to them by the learned trial Court. Learned counsel has further submitted that in view of this fact, the applicants-appellants do not want to pursue the present appeal on merits and the same may be disposed of.
