KULDEEP TIWARI, J.(Oral)

1. Through the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, a challenge is thrown to the Award dated 15.12.2000 (Annexure P-2), passed by respondent no.2.

2. This Court while admitting the instant petition vide order dated 13.03.2002, had stayed the operation of the impugned Award, subject to the compliance of provisions of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947 by both the parties.

3. When this Court confronted learned counsel for the petitioner, with the aforesaid order, while putting a specific query to her, as whether, the compliance of Section 17-B of the Industrial Disputes

Act, 1947, has been made till date or not, to which, she fairly concedes that no such compliance has been made till date. Further, it is also not coming forth that the petitioner still, intends to make compliance of the aforesaid direction of this Court.

4. In view of the above, the instant petition, is ordered to be **dismissed**.
