1 Petition herein is, *inter alia*, seeking a writ in the nature of Certiorari, for quashing of order dated 22.03.2000 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Collector, Yamunanagar and order dated 05.12.2000 (Annexure P-6) passed by learned Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala.

2. A perusal of order sheets reveals that on 23.01.2026, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“As per the office report, notice issued to respondents No.4 has been received back with the report ‘died’.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is directed to take necessary steps for impleading the legal heirs of deceased-respondent No.4.
