VIRINDER AGGARWAL, J. (Oral)

1. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the appellant. The same has been the position for quite some time. The appellant has remained unrepresented since 20.09.2024. Notice was also issued to the appellant, which has been received back duly served through his son-Haroon but despite such service, no one has appeared on behalf of the appellant, so it seems that appellant is not interested in pursuing the present appeal.
2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.
3. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to the appellant to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order.
