1. The present petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *certiorari* for quashing the impugned orders (Annexures P-2 and P-5).
2. The grievance of the petitioner, as per the pleadings, is that respondent No.7-Jaswant Singh, was nominated in the society by the Assistant Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Bathinda. The said order of nomination was subsequently set aside by the Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Bathinda. Thereafter, the aforesaid order passed by the Deputy Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Bathinda, was set aside by the Joint Registrar, Co-operative Societies, Ferozepur.
3. The present writ petition has been pending for the last 25 years.



4. No one has appeared on behalf of the petitioner today. On the last date of hearing, Mr. J.P.S. Sandhu, Advocate, appeared on behalf of the petitioner and submitted that he has no instructions from the petitioner. In view of his statement, notice was ordered to be issued upon the petitioner.

5. As per the report of the Registry, notice issued to petitioner has not been received back served or otherwise.

6. In view of the above, the present petition is hereby dismissed for non-prosecution.

7. However, in case any cause of action survives for the petitioner, then liberty is granted to him to revive the present petition, if so desired, by moving an appropriate application.
