The present revision petition is directed against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence dated 09.09.2004 passed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sangrur. By the said judgment, Amarjit Singh-respondent No.1 was ordered to be convicted for the offence punishable under Section 302 /34 IPC, whereas Hardip Singh-respondent No.2 was convicted for the offence punishable under Section 302 IPC. Both the appellants were sentenced to undergo imprisonment for life and to pay a fine of Rs. 20,000/-

each along with the stipulated default conditions.

The petitioner has prayed that the sentence of fine may be enhanced and some compensation may be awarded to legal representative(s) of Darbara Singh (since deceased).

Vide judgment of even date passed in a connected case, i.e. CRA-D-837-DB-2004 titled as 'Amarjit Singh and another Vs. State of Punjab and others', the appeal has been partly allowed qua Amarjit Singh, who has been arrayed as respondent No.1 in the present revision petition and he has been ordered to be acquitted of the charge, whereas the appeal qua Hardip Singh, who is respondent No.2 in the instant revision petition, has been dismissed. Hardip Singh-respondent No.2 has already been awarded RI for life and to pay a fine of Rs.20,000/- and there is no justification of enhancement of sentence of fine after 22 years of his conviction by the trial Court.

In view of above, the present revision petition is dismissed. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, accordingly.
