The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the petitioner benefit of the notional pay fixation and seniority with effect from 06.10.2017, the date her juniors have been appointed to the post of Assistant Professor (Botany).

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 18.12.2025, Annexure P-5, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Senior Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending representation, dated 18.12.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2/Director, Higher Education, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of three months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
