SUDEEPTI SHARMA J. (Oral)

1. The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of order dated 14.03.2024 passed by this Court in CWP-3309-2018, which was disposed of in terms of the decision passed in CWP No. 2158-2020 and connected matters whereby this Court disposed of the writ petitions by giving direction to the respondents to pass speaking order.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in compliance of the above referred to order, affidavit of Renu Bala, Dy. Conservator of Forests, Sonapat of respondent No. 3 was filed along with speaking order dated 13.11.2024 (Annexure R-1). However, despite the fact that speaking order was passed, this Court, vide order dated 10.03.2025 passed the following order:-

“1. By way of present petition, prayer has been made for initiation of contempt proceedings against the respondents for the alleged willful non-compliance of order dated 14.03.2024 passed by this Court. The operative part thereof is extracted hereunder:-

“In view of the above, the writ petitions are disposed of in the terms and conditions mentioned herein before. Let the respondent-State pass appropriate speaking order as directed herein before. In case, any of the petitioner is found entitled for regularization/retrospective regularization of services from the date employees junior to him/her has been regularized, they will be
