1. Instant petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 483 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 seeking regular bail in case FIR No.199 dated 15.12.2024 registered under Sections 21/29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 at Police Station STF, SAS Nagar.

2. Learned State counsel has produced custody certificate of the petitioner. A perusal of the same shows that the petitioner is involved in three other cases. However, reference of the same has not been given in the petition rather in para 26 it has been stated that the petitioner has no criminal antecedents and he is not involved in any other case/FIR.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on



the same cause of action with better particulars after giving the status of those cases.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
