The instant contempt petition alleges willful disobedience of the order dated 30.10.2025 (Annexure P-1) passed in CRM-M-31068-2020, vide which, in view of the reply filed stating that the cancellation report had been prepared and that the same would be submitted after compliance of necessary formalities in accordance with the rules and procedure within 4 weeks, the said petition was disposed of.

2. Short reply by way of an affidavit of Sh. Suhail Qasim Mir, Senior Superintendent of Police, District Amritsar (Rural) filed in Court today is taken on record. As per the same, the cancellation report stands submitted on 18.02.2026. Paragraph 6 of the reply states as under:-

“6. That thereafter, in view of the recommendations made in the aforesaid report and after completion of the requisite procedural formalities, the cancellation report was duly prepared and presented before the learned JMIC, Amritsar vide UCR No.60 of 2026 on 18.02.2026. The matter is presently pending consideration before the learned Court and the next date of hearing has been fixed for 04.04.2026.”

3. That being so, no further orders are required to be passed by this Court. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of. Rule stands discharged.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of.
