1. The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 29.08.2001 (Annexure P-3) vide which the candidature of the petitioner for the post of Head Master has been rejected. Further, seeking a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to count the experience gained by the petitioner as Instructor in the Indian Navy towards the calculation of period of 8 years experience, as required by advertisement and permit the petitioner to appear in the written test.

2. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner for the last two consecutive dates of hearing and notice was ordered to be issued to the petitioner.

3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back served, however, none has put in appearance on behalf of the petitioner. It appears that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the present petition.
4. Consequently, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the present petition in case any cause still survives.
5. Pending application, if any, shall also stand disposed of.
