VIKAS BAHL, J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that even now the payment has not been made.
2. Learned counsel for the respondents, on instructions from the Assistant Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, who is present in Court, has assured the Court that the payment in all the cases would be made within a period of two weeks from today and has further submitted that in case the same is not done, the respondent authorities would pay an amount of Rs.25,000/- in each of the contempt petition.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that in view of the same, the present contempt petitions be disposed of, but the respondent-State be bound by the statement made before this Court and liberty be granted to the petitioners to revive the petitions in case the respondents back track from the same.
4. Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present contempt petitions are disposed of. The respondents-State would be bound by their statement and the necessary payment be made to the petitioners within a period of two weeks from today. In case the same is not done, it would be open to the petitioners to revive the present contempt petitions and in such a situation, the respondents, as undertaken before this Court, would be liable to pay Rs.25,000/- in each petition, in



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addition to other amount due to the petitioners and also face action in contempt petitions.
