1. No one has put in appearance on behalf of the parties. On the previous date also, none was present. Counsels were informed by the Registry but even then none has put in appearance. This is an appeal pending since the year 2002. The suit relates qua relief of permanent injunction, so, it seems that the parties are not interested in pursuing the instant appeal.

2. In such circumstances, no useful purpose would be served by keeping the instant appeal on the docket, indefinitely.

3. Accordingly, the instant appeal stands dismissed for want of prosecution with liberty to the appellant to revive the same, if have any grievance from this order.

4. As a natural corollary, since the main case stands dismissed for want of prosecution, miscellaneous application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed of, as no fruitful purpose would be served by keeping them .
