NAMIT KUMAR, J. (ORAL)

1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Articles 14 and 16 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to release the Special Allowance/Administrative Allowance of Rs.200/- per month to the petitioners as per instructions dated 20.07.1998 and 18.11.1998, issued on the basis of the recommendations of the Fourth Pay Commission, forthwith with all consequential benefits along with interest @ 18% per annum.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that despite his best efforts, he has not been able to get instructions from the petitioners, therefore, he is not in a position to pursue the present petition.
3. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution with liberty to the petitioners to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
