1. Prayer in this petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to pay the amount of interest at the rate of 18% per annum on account of delay in payment of pensionary benefit i.e. pension, gratuity, leave encashment, provident fund etc.

2. Since there was no representation on behalf of the petitioner on the last date of hearing, fresh notice was ordered to be issued to the petitioner for today.

3. As per office report, notice issued to the petitioner has been received back unserved with the report that he is not residing at the given address.

4. In this view of the matter, the present petition is dismissed for non-prosecution. However, liberty is granted to the petitioner to revive the same in case any cause still survives.
