SURYA PARTAP SINGH. J.(Oral)

1. Learned counsel for the respondent has submitted that he has instructions from his party that they are going to withdraw the complaint before the learned trial Court qua petitioner Gian Vijeshwar, who has been impleaded party as representative of company arrayed as accused No.1. The learned counsel for the respondent has further contended that now the accused No.1-company will be prosecuted through Directors/authorised person.

2. In view of above-mentioned statement, learned counsel for the petitioner wants to withdraw this petition with liberty that in case the complaint is not withdrawn qua petitioner, he will have a liberty to approach this Court for revival of this petition.

3. In view of above, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn accordingly.
4. It is, however, clarified that the respondent/complainant shall be at liberty to pursue compliant against the accused No.1-company through Director.
5. All other pending applications, if any, are also disposed off, accordingly.
