The petition has been filed *inter alia* seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents not to take any coercive action against the petitioner including that of displacement, relieving or termination from the post of Extension Lecturer (Fine Arts) at Rajiv Gandhi Government College for Women, Bhiwani.

2. Learned State counsel has received instructions from respondent no.3/Director General, Higher Education, vide memo dated 06.04.2026, which is retained on the case file as Annexure 'A'. Referring to the same, she contends that even if the petitioner, who is working as Extension Lecturer, is to be replaced by transfer/deputation of a regularly selected candidate, he will be appropriately adjusted in any nearby Government College depending upon the workload, in terms of the policy dated 04.03.2020, as amended from time to time.

3. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
4. Ordered accordingly.
