The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, inter alia, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing of order dated 14.02.2000 (Annexure P-7) passed by learned Financial Commissioner, Haryana, order dated 26.02.1999 (Annexure P-5) passed by learned Commissioner, Gurgaon Division and 29.04.1997 (Annexure P-3) passed by learned Collector, Mahendergarh (Camp at Narnaul).

2. On 06.08.2024, the following order was passed by this Court:-
