1. The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, seeking a writ of certiorari, for quashing the order dated 03.12.2025 (Annexure P-8), passed by respondent No.2 declining the claim of the petitioner of granting pensionary benefits by taking into account her entire service. Further, a writ of mandamus has also been sought for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for grant of pensionary benefits by taking into account her entire service, including service rendered during suspension period and pay her the entire arrears along with 18% compound interest thereon from the date of her reinstatement in the service by considering representation dated 24.12.2025 (Annexure P-9) sent to respondent No.2.
2. After arguing the case for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars after

making necessary averments in the writ petition and attaching the relevant documents such as dissenting note and the order of punishment dated 22.04.2024.

3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
