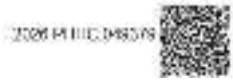

JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking directions to respondents to take an appropriate action against respondent No.5-Tula Ram on the basis of his complaint dated 12.11.2025 and restore/transfer electricity connection bearing Account No.50044 81000.

2. The petitioner claims that he is proprietor of M/s Shree Mahaveer Fuels and running a petrol pump located at National Highway No.8 Village Khijuri, Tehsil and District Rewari, Haryana. He obtained electricity connection in 2017 and regularly paid electricity charges. In November' 2025, he discovered that electricity connection has been transferred in the name of respondent No.5 on the basis of an affidavit containing his consent. He had never executed any such affidavit, thus, same is forged and fabricated. He had borrowed loan of ₹1,50,00,000/- from

respondent in April' 2021. He had executed mortgage deed dated



01.06.2021. Respondent No.5 fraudulently got executed a sale deed without payment of sale consideration by misrepresenting the loan amount as sale consideration. He has filed civil suit seeking cancellation of afore-stated sale deed which is pending adjudication before Civil Court at Rewari and next date is 14.04.2026 for filing written statement. He filed representation/complaint dated 12.11.2025 against respondent No.5 seeking action but to no avail.

3. Learned counsel for respondent Nos.2 to 5 assures the Court that competent authority would consider petitioner’s claim and address his representation within 2 months from today.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner agrees to aforesaid arrangement.

5. In the wake of statement of both sides, the petition stands disposed of.
