SURYA PARTAP SINGH, J. (Oral)

This petition for pre-arrest bail is the first petition filed by the petitioner(s) under Section 482 of 'the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita 2023'. It has been filed with regard to a case arising out of FIR No.381 dated 18.09.2025, for the commission of offence punishable under Section(s) 109(1), 115, 118(1), 118(2), 190, 191(3), 251(3) and 61 of Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (erstwhile 307, 321, 324, 326, 149, 148, 507 and 120-B of IPC), Police Station Pundri, District Kaithal.

2. Vide order dated 24.03.2026 the petitioner(s) was admitted to interim anticipatory bail, subject to the condition of furnishing bail/surety



bonds to the satisfaction of arresting officer. It was also directed that the petitioner(s) shall join the investigation.

3. It has been submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner(s) that in compliance with order dated 24.03.2026 the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation.

4. The learned State Counsel, on the instructions of ASI Jasbir Singh, has submitted that the petitioner(s) has joined the investigation, and that for further investigation of this case his custodial interrogation is not required.

5. Keeping in view the aforesaid submissions and the fact that the petitioner(s) has already joined the investigation, it is hereby ordered that the petitioner(s) is entitled for anticipatory bail. Hence, the present petition is hereby *allowed* and the order dated 24.03.2026, whereby the petitioner(s) was accorded the benefit of interim anticipatory bail, is hereby made absolute.
