1. In the present writ petition, the petitioners are praying for issuance of a direction to the respondents to release the arrears of dearness allowance on pay/revised pay as per the recommendations of the 6th Punjab Pay Commission, alongwith interest to the petitioners, in terms of the orders dated 20.12.2022 (Annexure P-1) and 28.03.2025 (Annexure P-2) w.e.f. 01.07.2021.

2. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners submits that similar issue has already been decided by this Court in **CWP No.30896 of 2025 titled as 'Deepak Sharma and others Vs. Union Territory of Chandigarh and others'** decided on 10.11.2025. Learned counsel further

submits that petitioners will be satisfied if a direction is given to respondents to consider the case of petitioners in light of the judgment rendered in **Deepak Sharma and others'** case (supra).

- 3. Notice of motion.
- 4. Mr. Shubham Chaudhary, Advocate for Mr. Tanmay Gupta, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of UT Chandigarh and could not dispute the contention made by learned counsel for the petitioners.
- 5. In view of the above and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to the respondents to consider and decide the case of petitioners in terms of the judgment passed by this Court in **Deepak Sharma and others'** case (supra), within a period of 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order, in accordance with law/rules.
- 6. In case, the petitioners are held entitled for grant of relief as claimed by them as per the rules/law, the same be also released within a period of 02 months thereafter.
- 7. Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand(s) disposed of accordingly.
