1. Petitioners Neha Rani and her minor daughter Tanusha through her natural guardian/mother filed petition under Section 528 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023/482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of direction to Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh to decide CRL MISC/32500 of 2024 titled "Neha vs Manoj Kumar" regarding proceedings of contempt of court within stipulated reasonable time period or any other direction which the Court may deem fit and proper in the given facts and circumstances of case.

2. Learned counsel representing petitioners informed that petitioners are granted interim maintenance vide order dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Chandigarh. Respondent Manoj Kumar has not paid the amount and disobeyed the aforesaid order, pertaining to which they have filed contempt petition (Annexure P-2). Said petition is pending since 23.08.2024.

Therefore, necessary directions be given to the Court concerned to decide contempt petition within stipulated time period.



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3. I have considered the petition filed by petitioners. From the aforesaid factual position, it is clear that petition filed under Section 125 Cr.P.C. is pending in which interim maintenance has been granted vide order dated 21.12.2023 (Annexure P-1). Learned counsel representing petitioners admitted that execution application is already filed on 16.03.2024 and next date fixed in execution application is 02.04.2026. Regarding passing of order on interim maintenance, execution application is already filed. Court concerned is to proceed as per law in execution proceedings as well as in proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C. At this stage, there is no occasion to file application for contempt proceedings. Therefore, no direction is required in present case and petition is, accordingly dismissed.

4. Pending miscellaneous application, if any, shall also stands disposed of accordingly.
