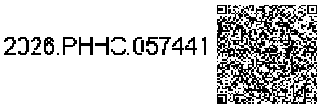
KULDEEP TIWARI, J. (Oral)

1. Aggrieved by the order dated 27.11.1998 (Annexure P-3) passed by the learned Labour Court, vide which, the application filed by respondent No.1, under Section 33 (c)(2) of the Industrial Disputes Act, was allowed, thereby directing the petitioner-Management to pay her an amount of Rs.35,900/-, it has approached this Court under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India.

2. On 25.03.2026, this Court had passed the hereinafter extracted order:-

“Mr. K.K.Gupta, Advocate, has caused appearance on behalf of the petitioner, and submits that he has recently been engaged. Therefore, he seeks an adjournment to address the arguments.

A perusal of the previous interim orders, reflects that there is no stay operating against of the impugned Award. Therefore, learned counsel for the petitioner, is directed to file a



specific affidavit disclosing therein, the present status respondent no.1-workman.

Adjourned to 16.04.2026, for arguments.”

3. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions from the Secretary, submits that since the disputed amount has already been remitted to respondent No.1, the petitioner-Society does not intend to pursue the instant writ petition any further.

4. **Dismissed** as not pressed.
