1. The present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider and grant appointment to the petitioner being a dependent of the land owner whose land was acquired for setting up Indira Gandhi super thermal power project, Jharli (Jhajjar) in terms of policy dated 05.07.2007 (Annexure P-3). Further for directing the respondents to consider and decide the legal notice/representation dated 03.10.2025 within the stipulated period by passing a speaking and reasoned order in accordance with law, policy dated 05.07.2007 (Annexure P-3) and the judgment dated 08.08.2023 passed by this Court in CWP No.12836 of 2018 (Annexure P-11) and also to abide by the promise made at the time of acquisition by providing employment to one member of the family whose land has been acquired and to release all consequential incentives allowed vide policies P-9 and P-10 including annual incentive @ Rs.21,000/- per acre with enhancement of Rs.750/- per year for a period of 33 years.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to invoke alternative appropriate remedy as available to him in accordance with law.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
