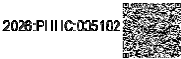
The petition has been filed, *inter alia*, seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to give appointment to the petitioner with effect from the date candidate lower in merit was allowed to join the Department.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that grievance raised herein is pending for appropriate decision before the respondents. At this stage, the petitioner will be satisfied in case respondent no.2 is directed to decide the pending representation, dated 16.11.2025, Annexure P-10, in a specified period.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Ms. Tanushree Gupta, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents/State and submits that the pending representation, dated 16.11.2025, will be decided by respondent no.2/Secretary, Haryana Staff Selection Commission, by passing a speaking/reasoned order in accordance with law within a period of two

months.



5. In view of the statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner has no objection to the petition being disposed of in terms thereof.
6. Ordered accordingly.
7. In case the order is not passed within the stipulated period, the officer concerned shall pay costs of ₹50,000 to the petitioner.
