1. Prayer in the present petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case FIR No.16 dated 25.01.2025, registered under Section 120-B, read with Section 381, 408, 420, 467, 468, 471, 506 IPC, at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamunanagar.
2. By virtue of order dated 08.07.2025, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated with the same. He submits that even as per the FSL report, culpability of the petitioner is not proved and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute.
4. Learned Senior Counsel for the complainant has submitted that money has been transferred in the account of the wife of the petitioner.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Prem Chand has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation. He submits that though FSL report is received, however, the same is not conclusive, whereas, the voice sample is conclusive.
5. In view of the facts and circumstances of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 08.07.2025 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) of Bhartiya Nagrik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
