AARADHNA SAWHNEY, J. (ORAL)

1. By virtue of the present petition under Section 482 BNSS, petitioner, an accused in case bearing FIR No.10 dated 16.01.2026 registered under Sections 406/420/467/468/471/120-B/506 IPC at Police Station Julana, Distt. Jind, has prayed for grant of pre-arrest bail.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI, Anoop Singh, states that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not needed for any further investigation. Learned State counsel further states that the matter has also been amicably resolved between the parties.

3. On 07.03.2026, following order was passed by a coordinate Bench of this Court:-

“Inter alia contends that the matter has now been amicably settled between the parties, and the custodial interrogation of the petitioner would only result in ignominy to the petitioner & the petitioner is willing to join the investigation and cooperate therein.

Issue notice of the application in hand.

On the strength of advance notice; Mr. Deepak Kumar Grewal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent.

Mr. Deepak Jaglan, Advocate for Mr. Amit Malik, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the complainant and has filed his memorandum of appearance in Court today. The same be taken on record. He has ratified the aspect of the matter having been settled between the parties. The petitioner is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer on 09.03.2026 at 11:00 A.M. in concerned Police Station and join investigation. In the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bond(s) to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer. As and when further called by Investigating Officer, the petitioner shall join the investigation. He shall abide by the condition(s) enumerated under Section 482(2) of the BNSS.

Put up the application along with the main case, which is slated to be listed for hearing on 12.03.2026.”

4. Keeping in view the fact that petitioner has joined the investigation, interim bail granted vide order dated 07.03.2026 is hereby confirmed, subject to conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS. Further the petitioner is directed to join investigation as and when required in future by way of written notice for such purpose to be served by Investigating Officer of this case upon the petitioner; he will not tamper with the evidence nor will influence the witnesses and will not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.

5. The petition stands allowed.

6. Pending application, if any, also stands disposed of.
