The petition primarily alleges breach of the mandatory provisions of Section 107 of the BNSS and seeks a direction for strict implementation of Section 19(a) to (c) of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988.

The pleadings in the petition reveal that the allegations are of a generic nature, lacking in specificity. The petitioner has not assigned any instances of breaches which have actually taken place.

We cannot accept such a half-baked PIL.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed, with liberty to file a properly constituted petition.
