(1) Learned counsel for the parties agree that the issue raised through this petition is covered in the petitioner's favour by a recent judgment of a Coordinate Bench dated 28.05.2025 passed in ***CWP No.12986 of 2025 – M/s J B B Traders Vs. Union of India and others.***

(2) In the light of the afore consensus, this petition is also allowed in terms of the judgment passed in ***M/s J B B Traders's*** case (supra).
