The petitioner seeks the grant of anticipatory bail under Section 482 BNSS, 2023 in case bearing FIR No.836 dated 30.10.2025 under Sections 316(2), 316(5), 318(4), 338, 336(3), 340(2), 344, 61 BNS, 2023 (Erstwhile Sections 406, 409, 420, 467, 468, 471, 477-A, 120-B IPC) and Sections 7, 12, 13(2) PC Act (added later on) registered at Police Station Sadar Karnal, District Karnal, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the interim order dated 12.03.2026 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The learned State counsel on instructions submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation in terms of the order dated 12.03.2026 and is not required for custodial interrogation.

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In view of the above, the interim order dated 12.03.2026 is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 482(2) BNSS.

The petition stands disposed of.
