1. This is second petition for bail filed by the petitioner. The learned counsel for the petitioner has requested that at this stage he would like to withdraw this petition. It has also been requested that in the present case out of twenty four prosecution witnesses not even a single witness has been examined, and therefore, a direction be given to learned trial Court to dispose of the petition in a time bound manner.

2. In view of above-mentioned submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is hereby dismissed as withdrawn. However, the learned trial Court is hereby directed to dispose of the trial, which is already more than two years and nine months, within a period of four months from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
