The instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of *Certiorari* for quashing of order dated 14.06.2000 (Annexure P-4), whereby, the unauthorized water course has been ordered to be restored.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that despite repeated remainders/calls to the petitioner, no body has responded. He further submits that as on date, he has no instructions, and therefore, is unable to assist the Court any further in this matter.
