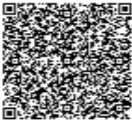

The present Civil Writ Petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus or any other appropriate writ, order, or direction directing the respondents to release salary to the petitioner in the pay scale of Rs.1100-20-1400 w.e.f. the date he assumed duties along with annual increments, and thereafter in the scale of Rs.2170-40-2810 w.e.f. 01.01.1992, along with all consequential increments and revised pay scales as implemented by the respondents from time to time. Further a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondents to release to him all benefits made available to him in the nature of house rent allowance, medical allowance etc., as per his offer of appointment (Annexure P-1). A further writ is sought declaring the petitioner to be a regular



employee of the respondents and entitling him to all financial and service benefits available to Peon-cum-Messengers from the date of his entry into service in terms of order dated 02.04.1991.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that the instant petition has become infructuous in light of judgment passed by Hon’ble Supreme Court in National Fertilizers Ltd. & others V/s. Dinesh Kumar, Civil Appeal No.466 of 2024.

In view of above submission, the present petition is disposed as having been rendered infructuous.
