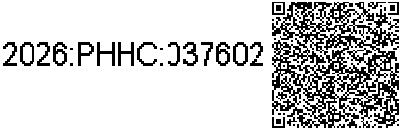
1) The lackadaisical and indolent approach of the authorities concerned in not taking any final decision upon the charge-sheet dated 20.12.2023 (Annexure P-1), has propelled the petitioner to knock the doors of this Court through the instant writ petition, as cast under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India.

2) On 05.03.2026, this Court had passed the hereinafter extracted order:-

“1. At this stage, without issuing notice, learned State counsel is directed to have appropriate instructions from the respondent No.1, and to apprise this Court of the time period within which a final decision is proposed to be taken on the chargesheet issued to the petitioner.

2. List on 11.03.2026 in the urgent list.

3) Today, learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Adesh Garg, XEN, PWD (National Highway Division), fairly submits that the final



decision upon the charge-sheet (supra), shall be taken, in accordance with law, within a period of one month from today.

4) In view of the abovesaid statement made by learned State counsel, no further order is required to be passed in the instant writ petition, and the same is accordingly, **disposed of**.

5) This Court is sanguine that the authorities concerned shall strictly adhere to the timeline, as indicated by the learned State counsel.
